Micrograms

A quarter of a million documents a week can be handled by the British War Office microgram service.

Microscopic negatives are made by the microgram units abroad on films of varying lengths, which are then sent home by air. As a result, official correspondence is speeded up and transmission of such documents as adjustment of allowances to soldiers' dependents, formerly sent by rail and sea, frequently take only a few days as they previously took months.

One hundred feet of film may bear the negatives of as many as 1,600 documents in a container which is no bigger than a 2-ounce tobacco tin. On arrival at the War Office the films are enlarged at the rate of 1,600 documents an hour.

24 Hours a Day For 68 Years

The eerie shriek of the siren marked a low moment as the ambulance rumbled to a quick stop beside the crowd collected around the crumpled heap by the roadside. Tender hands lifted onto the stretcher what had been a happy care-free youngster but a few short minutes before the doors closed and the car glided swiftly away with its burden on pain, bound for the Hospital for Sick Children—that splendid institution which for 68 years has waged unceasing war against sickness, disease and death.

READY FOR ANY EMERGENCY
The Hospital stands ready at all times to meet any emergency. Accident cases are not the only ones which must be promptly attended. Children with deformed heads and limbs, defective eyesight, rare diseases and physical disabilities must have prompt help too. Neglect may mean permanent disfigurement, deformity or chronic disease. While fourteen days is the average case of public ward patients is treated, a large number are inmates for weeks, some for months and a few receive treatment over a period of years. Many are problem cases, sent there because of the world-wide reputation earned by the doctors who devote their time and talents without stint in the service of suffering little ones.

CAUSE FOR PRIDE
Though the Hospital for Sick Children is situated in the City of Toronto, it belongs essentially to all the people of Ontario because it welcomes children from every part of the Province who are in need of medical aid or hospital care. No exceptions are ever made. There is no barrier of race or creed, children of parents from every walk of life find sanctuary. Those who cannot be served there, those who cannot be served away. The people of Ontario may feel proud of this institution, this living monument to our democratic way of life.

Some idea of the immense value and wide scope of the Hospital's work can be formed from the fact that during the past year alone, over 800,000 visits were recorded in its public wards, 47,000 in the Out-patient department,

King George VI was 48 on December 14, 1896. His Majesty was the second son of King George V and Queen Mary. He was born at Windsor Palace.

When the present King was born, it was not anticipated that he would ever rule the British Empire. His older brother, Edward, Prince of Wales, was designated for the throne. As Duke of York, the present King and Emperor moved abroad as the younger son, never pushing forward, always content to assume his less important role.

After King George V died in 1936, Edward VIII became King on January 20, 1936. When the Simpson divorce brought the abdication of Edward VIII, the present King ascended the throne as George VI on December 11, 1936.
