Two pounds of fat will fire a burst of 20 cannon shells from a Spitfire or 10 anti-aircraft shells. BONES produce fat and aircraft glue. If we saved fat at the rate of one ounce per person per week this would mean 36,000,000 pounds of glycerine for explosives. OUR FIGHTERS DEPEND ON YOU. Every householder who delivers to a retail butcher, collector, or Salvage Committee, any rendered or unrendered fats or bones shall be entitled to receive from the person to whom they are delivered 4 cents per pound net weight for rendered fats, and 1 cent per pound for unrendered fats. NOTICE TO BUTCHERS, HOTELS, ETC. You have been mailed a copy of Order A-642. This Order affects operators of hotels, restaurants and other establishments where meals are served.
