YOU MUST MAKE A 1942 INCOME TAX RETURN NOT LATER THAN JUNE 30th. IF SINGLE and your net income exceeded \$6600. IF MARRIED and your net income exceeded \$12000.

Under the new system introduced this year, Income Tax is now on a pay-as-you-earn basis. The reduction of the 1942 Tax made this possible. In most cases the larger part of the reduced tax will have been paid by the 1942 tax deductions or installment payments.

FARMERS. You must attach to your return on Form T. 1 Special or Form T. 1 General either a statement of your gross income and expenses, or completed Farmers T. 1 Supplemental. The T. 1 Supplemental itemizes all forms of farm receipts and expenses, and is a guide for determining your actual net income.

On The Farm Front

BRIEF NOTES FOR THE BUSY FARMER. — By Haldimand Harry — What to do with those unwanted fields is a vexatious problem that must be faced these days. We have heard it suggested that in some cases the growth of grass is such that a reasonably good crop of hay can be cut.

Advance relief from some quarters point to a probable scarcity of some kinds of clover seed particularly alfalfa. This makes it important for Haldimand farmers to get their seed fields a bit of extra care this year.

It is not unlikely that a considerable acreage will be sown to fall wheat this year. This may not be a bad practice to follow either.

Weeds on roadsides came in for a lengthy discussion at the Annual Weed Meeting last week. Opinion was expressed on the advisability of permitting weeds to pasture. It is true that in certain seasons the weeds would do a great deal of damage and also in our age of speed there would be danger from traffic.

Dr. Stephen related that in his home township of East Missouri local by-law permitted the pasturing of roadsides for a limited number of hours each evening, providing the cattle or other stock were herded. This proved to be an economical method of keeping many troublesome weeds in check. Willing Township in Waterloo is another township in which this example of roadside pasturing.
