Fall Fairs Restored To Original Purpose

Speaking at the annual convention of the Class "B" Fairs Association in Toronto, Dr. G. I. Christie, president of the O.A.C., Guelph, emphasized the necessity of keeping fall fairs active during the war. "It would have been a great calamity to discontinue these fairs," said Dr. Christie. "The people wanted them, the war effort needed them and war production has increased because of them." Dr. Christie expressed the view that wartime conditions have produced a great improvement in these fairs from an agricultural standpoint and have restored them to their original purpose. He also referred to the effect of rural fairs on the improvement of living quarters last year has been removed. 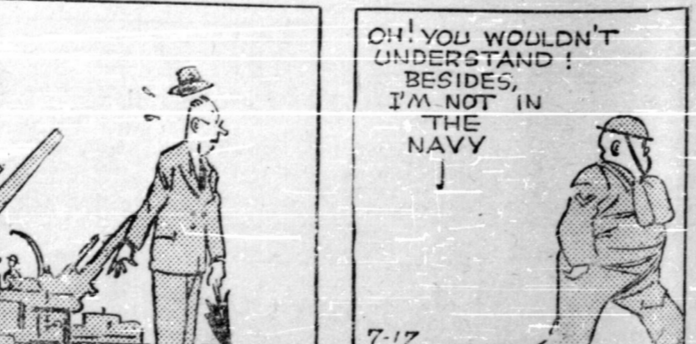

Tokyo Said Ready For Air Attacks

A DNB radiocast from Germany quoted the Mayor of Tokyo as declaring that officials of the city "anticipate and are prepared for air attacks." "We are using not only the experience gained through the bombing of Berlin and other German cities but above all our own practical lessons learned from the great earthquake of 1923," he was quoted as saying. "Along with obvious air raid protection measures there also is a systematic dispersal of the population of this city of 8,000,000."

Nazi Gives Self Up To Aid Allies

A German who deserted the Nazis and who gave himself up to the British a short time ago was officially identified by Allied spokesmen as Erik Verheuren, clerk to the military attaché in the German embassy at Istanbul and a son of the German attorney, Petra Verheuren. The 27-year-old attaché and his wife declared they detested the Germans because they were disgusted with Nazi brutality. He is said to possess detailed information of greatest value. At the German embassy he served directly under Dr. Paul Leverkuehn, assistant military attaché in Turkey. Verheuren said he and his wife reached Allied controlled territory despite every effort by Germans in Turkey to apprehend him. Under investigation by the Gestapo, he disappeared several days ago. German Ambassador Franz von Papen hurriedly vacated in the Bursa Mountains to rush back to Istanbul in order to direct an investigation of his disappearance.
