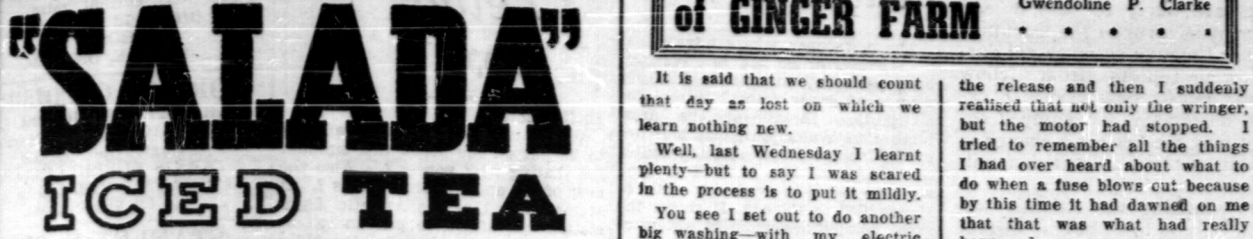

German Submarines Had Our Tables

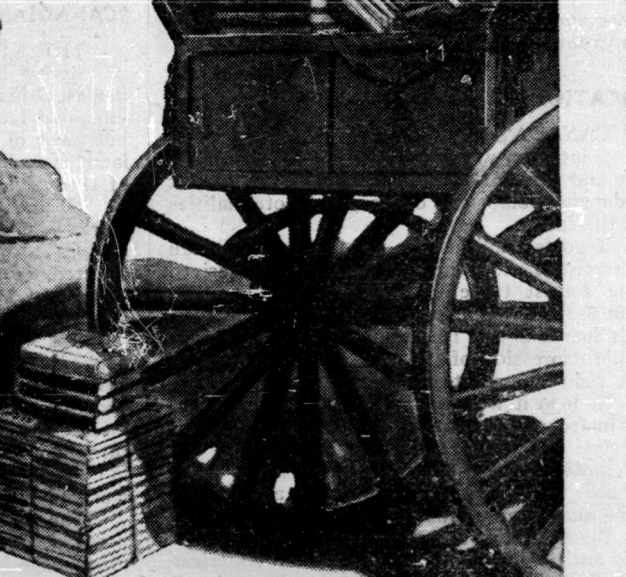

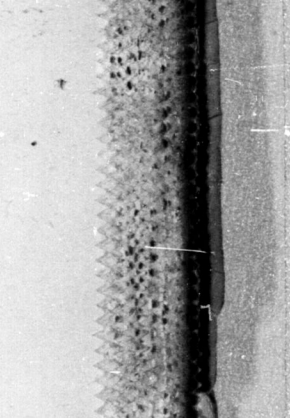
