7. Wheat Acreage Reduction and Prairie Farm Income payments made in 1944 to tide farmers over until market for wheat found.

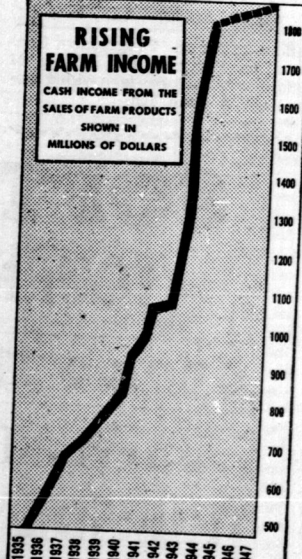
8. Export contracts, operative until 1947, act as floor prices under farm products.

9. The above, with the Export Credits Insurance Act, will maintain farm incomes throughout post-war period.

10. Appointed (August 1944) Agricultural Prices Support Board to guarantee for post-war security to farmers' incomes.

11. To enable farmers to improve their working and living conditions, your Liberal Government has provided for intermediate and short term credits by amending the Bank Act and passing the Farm Improvement Loans Act, and further, has arranged that those wishing to build new homes or repair, extend or renovate their present homes can borrow the money under the National Housing Act.

12. Inaugurated annual farm production programmes through co-operation between the Department of Agriculture and farmers' organizations in every part of Canada.

LONG DRESSES STILL RANDED

For the past two years the War-time Prices and Trade Board has forbidden the "manufacture for sale" of long dresses except for brides and religious orders. This restriction is of particular importance because it represents the saving of an appreciable amount of material. Unfortunately it is a very difficult regulation to enforce—except in the case of the large manufacturers who sell their goods through the retail stores. With the individual dress-maker and the home dressmaker it is a question of making an appeal that they should comply with the regulation on the grounds that conservation of textiles is absolutely necessary and it is definitely "not done" to have new long dresses.

To lift the ban because a few people ignored the order—and got away with it—would be to abandon a programme that has already saved large quantities of much needed textiles, and would hardly be compatible with the Board's sponsorship of the Clothes Conservation Campaign.
