



Individuals have more than trebled their savings in bank ac counts, government securities and other liquid assets since 1938. It was estimated that at May 3: 1945, individual Canadians had in currency, bank deposits, refund able taxes and dominion government securities more than \$9,500,000,000 — representing an increase of more than \$6,500,000,000 com-pared with 1938 — and this does not include savings in the form of life insurance, pensions, homes or corporate securities.

The intensive campaign to borrow from individuals has borne good fruits. The number of individual subscribers grew from 946,-549 in the first victory loan to 3 .-178,275 in the eighth loan last May. It is the hope of those inter-ested in the economy of both the country and individuals that this great number of subscribers will be maintained or exceeded in the


