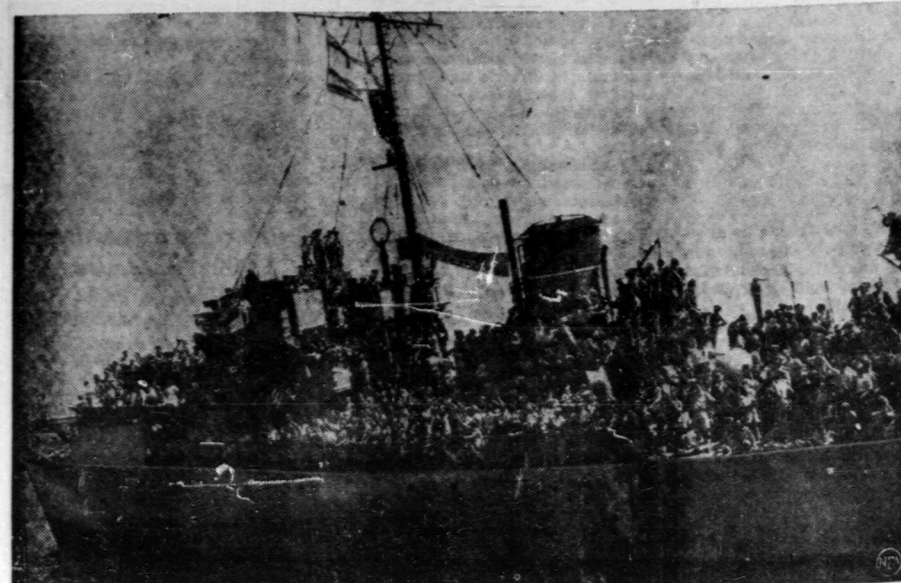


"NOTHING CAN KEEP US FROM OUR HOMELAND"



In the dark of a mid-summer night recently, a former Canadian corvette, the Josiah Wedgwood, slipped from an unnamed European port and headed for Palestine. About the vessel, crammed into every inch of deck space, above, were 1300 Jewish refugees, seeking escape from authorities and refuge in Palestine. Their journey and their destination were illegal, but a makeshift banner, left proudly ported by their spirit and defied intervention. Seventy-three miles out at sea British warships spotted the outlaw craft, lay in wait until it entered territorial waters, then closed in. The corvette halted only after a British destroyer fired three shots in warning. The refugees, below, their flight a failure, quietly accepted detention. They were held at Athlit Clearance Camp at Haifa, Palestine, on an official charge of being a "menace to navigation."

Battles or bets, "Monty" just couldn't lose. He won £5 from Maj.-Gen. Churchill C. Proof is the filing card reproduced above. Maj.-Gen. Mann's handwriting is as follows: "Brig. C. C. Mann bets £5 to . . . that the war with Germany will not finish before 1-8-45." The wager is acknowledged in the lower corners by the signatures of Brig. Mann and Field Marshal Montgomery, and the date 23-10-44. At the left, centre, is the inscription "Received, thank you. B. L. Montgomery, Field Marshal, 6-5-44."

Highlights of the News

Polymer Output High
United States state department announced Britain has accepted "in principle" the United States government's proposal to unify occupation zones in Germany.
The department's announcement reiterated the hope that Russia and France likewise will accept.
Despite this hope, the expectation among diplomats in Washington is that the United States and Britain at once will work out details for unifying their own zones economically, that France probably will join promptly and that Russia will refuse to co-operate.
The announcement which may mark a step in the hardening of the great power split in Germany came as Secretary of State Byrnes met with Prime Minister Attlee and Foreign Ministers Molotov and Bidault in the first day of the Paris peace conference.

General Strike in Calcutta
British troops were alerted to stand by for possible riots as a one-day hartal (general protest strike) called in sympathy with the postal telegraph workers completely paralyzed Calcutta, a city of 4,500,000.
Tension mounted as armed civilians patrolled the front of the radio-equipped trucks working through the streets shouting "open the Treasury."
There were no immediate reports of violence.
All transportation—trolleys, taxis and rickshaws—was at a standstill. Newspapers suspended publication. Mercantile firms, banks, offices and factories shut down. Steel grills were locked in front of most shops, especially in the European section, which suffered the brunt of attacks in riots last February.

World Food Forecast
A United States Department of Agriculture report says world food supply for next year, Europe's food production may reach 90 per cent of the present average, it was said, but famine was forecast for India and China.

Cattle Prices at New Top
Choice cattle broke the all time price record when one lead sold at Union Stockyards, Chicago, for \$28.50. Ten other leads brought \$26.25. The record set just a week ago was \$26.35. Best heps at \$22 equalled the modern price record set last week, the highest in 27 years.

Yanks to Leave Italy
State Secretary Byrnes said the United States troops would be withdrawn from Italy 90 days after the effective date of the Italian peace treaty.
Presumably his press conference statement also contemplated the simultaneous withdrawal of British troops from Italy.

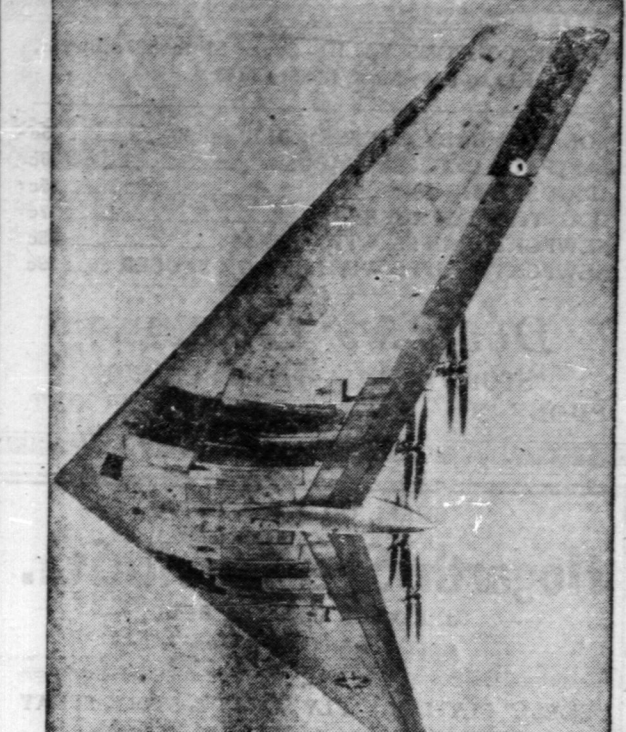

About as funny a thing as has come up in our golf world of sport in quite some time was the recent action of Mister Ellsworth Vines, golfer and tennis extraordinary. (In case you have forgotten about it by the time this gets into print, Mister Vines is the man who forfeited \$675 of his prize money rather than travel around in a golf tournament bearing the stigma of a numbered tag.)

Or if Mister Vines had entirely refused to accept any of the vulgar money of a crowd so benighted that they couldn't tell him of the great Ellsworth, without the aid of a number, we might have pegged him as a slight screwball, but still one who stuck up for his principles no matter what the cost.

In explanation of his weird procedure—an athlete refusing money under any circumstances whatsoever strikes us as nothing less than weird—Mister Vines said it was a matter of "dignity before dough." In other words, he considered it quite beneath his dignity to wear a number so that the huge crowd following the play—the same crowd whose admission fees made such a lucrative tournament possible—would be able to distinguish one player from another.

Now if Mister Vines had been competing as an amateur in an open tournament—like Bobby Jones of old—and wished to have that fact clearly known, it would have been quite another matter. In English cricket the "gentlemen" used to be—maybe still are for all we know—distinguished from the pros by the fact that they were amateurs.

So all that remains is to laugh—and to recommend Mister Vines to try some of those cold compresses, used for the reduction of tumid joints, on his aristocratic dome. And it's rather a pity, because Ellsworth Vines was one of the finest tennis players that ever swung a racket, and now he's right up among the best of them at golf. And any man who can get to the top in those two sports— which, as played in fast company nowadays, probably take more skill, strategy and plain guts than any other games whatever—should be above such petty stuff as he pulled in Chicago.

For, Heaven knows, if people can be found who are willing to pay real money for the privilege of traumping several miles around a golf course, on a hot sticky day, to watch a lot of other guys sweat a little pill, the least they deserve is to know who they are looking at.

U. S. Family Incomes
