But with Durnan on the sidelines, the Hurtling Habs ceased to hurtle and went into a tailspin that dropped them from first to third place. Then last week-end Durnan returned to the lineup and Canadiens promptly regained antly, their winning ways. They knocked off Chicago 6-2 and followed through with a 2-0 win over Boston.

Now they're back in the contention for top honors and the flags have ceased to fly at halfmast in Moreal.

By the time this appears, a decision on Walter (Babe) Pratt's case should be announced. I hockey's inner circles it is anticipate dthat Pratt will be reinstated and that it's quite possible he may rejoin the Maple Leafs for Saturday night's important game with Canadiens in Toronto.

The Leafs, incidentally, are hockey's hottest team of the moment. They've lost only two games in their last eleven starts--and both to Boston. They've won six and tied three . . . which, in short, means they've taken 15 of their last 22 points. As the baseballers would say, that's a .681 average.

Even without Babe Pratt in their last five games, the Leafs managed to win one; lose one and tie three. The return of Turk Broda to the nets has bolstered the Toronto defense considerably for the Turk stepped back into the N.H.L. picture--after being away for 21/2 years--as if he had never left the scene.

It took Brimsek a month to whip himself into condition for a return to NHL conmpetition--and when he did make his debut he was beaten eight times. Broda, back in Canada little more than a week was propelled into action against Boston Bruins in Beantown and played fine game in that 3-3 tie. 


