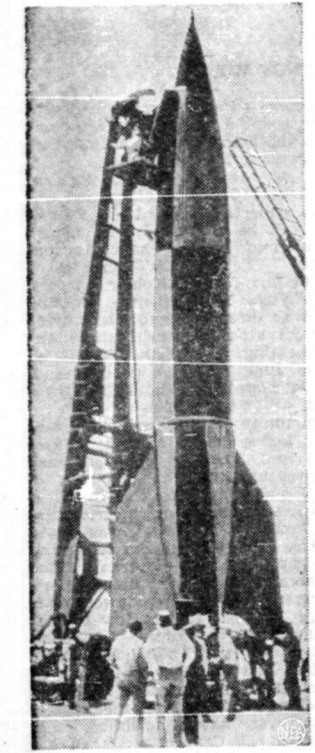


STILTED HUMOR

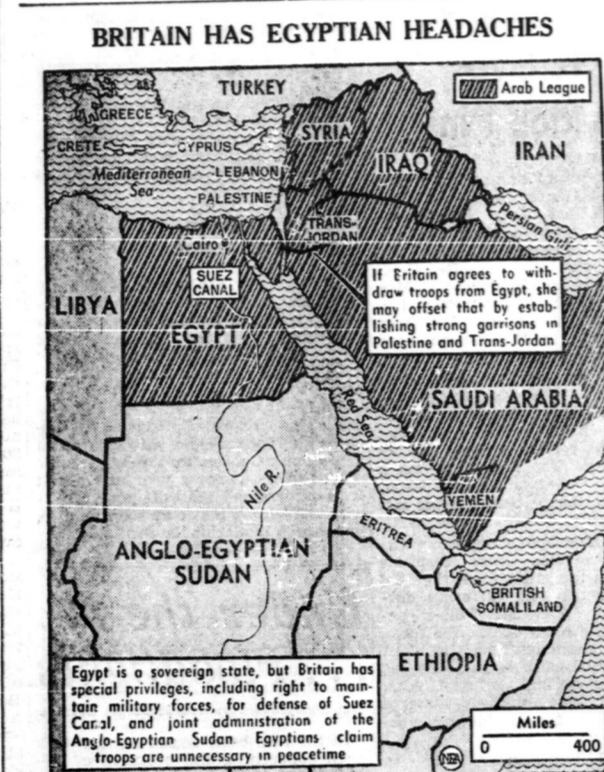
HIGH COMMISSIONER

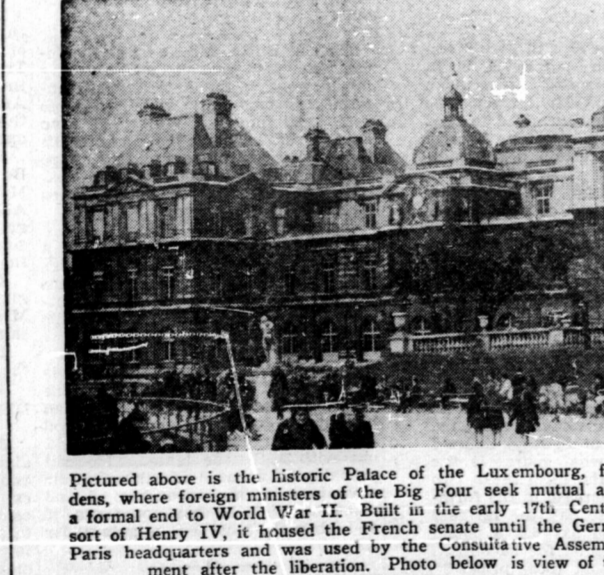
Practical Gardening

WHERE BIG FOUR WRESTLE WITH PEACE PROBLEMS



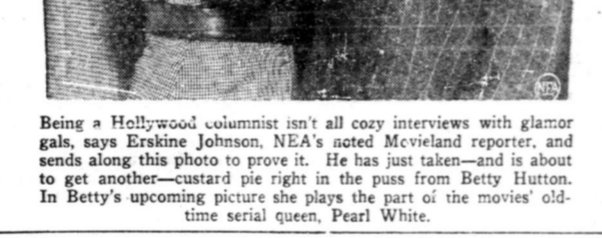
Pictured above is the historic Palace of the Luxembourg, facing Paris' famed Luxembourg Gardens, where foreign ministers of the Big Four seek mutual agreement on peace terms that will put a formal end to World War II. Built in the early 17th Century for Maria de Medici, queen consort of Henry IV, it housed the French senate until the German occupation, served the Germans as Paris headquarters and was used by the Consultative Assembly of the French provisional government after the liberation. It's True That... with the slow-up in slaughtering in government inspected packing plants, meat scrap and tankage supplies will be far below the demand; also the diversion of materials from livestock feed to human food. Generally, the protein feed situation develops an acute shortage of supplies. Pilehead fish meal production on the Pacific Coast is considerably below that of the previous year and herring meal production is also down.
