Or "HOW DOES YOUR GARDEN GROW?"

Make Plans Now. There are a lot of things a gardener can do before the ground is ready for planting, and it is not a bit too early, either, to start looking around for things to be replaced.

Grass Seed Early, Too. Grass loves cool weather. If it doesn't get the stars while there is plenty of moisture in the ground and before the sun gets too hot, new seedling will not give best results. So, just as soon as one can walk on the ground without getting one's shoes really muddy, is the time to plant new lawn or re-lawn.

Good seed with lawn is vitally important. For special purposes like shady places, there are special types of grass or mixtures. Select a day with as little wind as possible to sow the grass seed, and sow it both across and lengthwise. Sow plenty of seed and fertilize. Thick, well-fed grass will crowd out most weeds.
