



A question often asked, especially by those who have installed sep tic tanks fairly recently, is whether there is any danger in running into such tanks soapy water, or water in

soaps, or any of the new "detergent taken with the use of strong useful bacteria which work in the septic tanks are even more easily

So great care should be taken about the use of concentrated lye, chlorine solutions, chloride of lime, carbolic acid and other strong disinfectants. Water in which any of these has been used should go some place other than into your septic tank.

It has been estimated that the livestock industry in Canada and the United States is being robbed of up to one hundred and fifty million dollars a year-and not by packing plants, price controls, lack of price controls, or anything of the sort. The robbers referred to are internal livestock parasites.
