**Next Week - Farm Forum Spring Rally Held At Rural Youth Centre**  
Haldimand County Farm Forum chairman Mr. Stanley Covell, Chairman of the Haldimand County Farm Forum Committee, held his Annual Spring Round-up at the Rural Youth Centre, Kohler, on March 28th. The spacious auditorium was filled to overflowing with over 350 farm forum members of our twenty-six forums assembled to see National Film Board pictures and the Special Farm Forum Broadcast in the Auditorium and the Rooms respectively, also to hear an outstanding address by Mr. R. W. Morrison, President of the Ontario Federation of Agriculture. Chairman Morrison spoke in general terms of the work of the Federation of Agriculture and the important part Farm Forums were playing in Haldimand County. He stated that progress has been made in improving the relationship between agricultural and non-agricultural organizations as well as the government of our Province and the Dominion. Specific accomplishments were hard to point your finger to, but there is definitely a better feeling towards agriculture and consultations. Mr. Morrison expressed his appreciation to the members of the forum and said that he was pleased to report that the 2nd reading of the Progressive Conservative bill to amend the Agricultural Products Act had been passed during the afternoon of March 22nd. Mr. Morrison stated that he was sure that two members voting in the negative, in spite of scores of telegrams on the members' desks as a last minute endeavour of the majority interests to defeat the bill, had been changed to a successful vote of the farmers' feeling.
