## On the Farm Front

BRIEF NOTES FOR THE BUSY FARMER  
— By Haldimand Harry —

During the month of November, Haldimand Producers of Swine marketed 1,787 head through inspected plants. Of this number, 687 or 38-44 per cent were in the top grade. This is just about the lowest percentage of top grade hogs that has been marketed by Haldimand Producers during the past ten years or more. Most of the balance of hogs were in the 2d Grade, and 81's are largely hogs of reasonably good type, but hogs that have been marketed either too heavy or too light in weight. Haldimand Producers are urged to send their pigs to market at the proper weight. Top quality hogs can be produced in Haldimand and our percentage of Grade A hogs should be fifty per cent or better instead of below forty per cent.

"Moisture" is the general theme of the Annual Meeting of the Ontario Crop Improvement Association to be held in Toronto next month, on January 15, 16 and 17. Haldimand County will no doubt be well represented at this meeting, particularly in view of the fact that the President, this year, L. B. Mohlenbacher is a resident of the County. Dr. L. L. Harrold, of the U.S. Soil Conservation Service and Director of the Hydrological Experimental Station at Cobden will be one of the speakers. The Right Honourable James G. Gardiner, Minister of Agriculture for the Dominion will be the speaker for the Banquet.

Haldimand breeders having beef bulls for sale are reminded that all entries for this event to be held on March 20 next year, should be made to the Livestock Commissioner, on or before January 20th. Prospective buyers of beef bulls are also reminded that financial assistance is offered by the Ontario Department of Agriculture up to one-third of the purchase price with a maximum of \$150.00 per bull. Sale will be held at the Royal Winter Fair Building in Toronto.

Some small quantities of foundation forage crop seeds will again be available for the 1951 season. Anyone desiring such seed should secure an application form and after completing it, forward it immediately to the Department of Field Husbandry, Ontario Agricultural College. This is particularly true in the case of alfalfa and red clover. Application forms can be secured from your Agricultural Representative.
