-oOo-Cattle, under normal stabling con-ditions ar very subject to infestations of lice and should an outbreak occur in any herd, immediate steps should taken to institute measures of con most economical treatments and this can be applied with a brush at the rate of four ounces per cow. The treatment should be repeated at intervals of twenty days or less. Raw linseed oil is free from poisonous properties and should be used instead of boiled oil. The section should not be brushed too hard and animals receiving the treatment should not be ceiving the treatment should not be exposed to strong sunlight for at least twelve hours to avoid oil burns. Neither should the cattle be exercised or over-heated during that period.

-000-With the open winter season there is a possibility that wheat fields will suffer more damage and to improve such a condition farmers should be such a condition farmers should be prepared to apply a top dressing of some type of fertilizer to assist with carly growth in the Spring. One of the best of these is Ammonium Nitrate or Nitraprills. This is a nitrogen carrying fertilizer supplying in the neighborhood of 33% nitrogen. Generally speaking it is applied at the rate of about forty pounds of nitrogen to the acre or 120 pounds of nitrapril's. In tests which have been made across the Province the increased yield where this fertilizer

been made across the Province the increased yield where this fertilizer was applied amounted to over ten bushels per acre, with the highest gain of 29 bushels per acre.


