produced as a result of the increased vitamin content. He goes on to suggest that every breeder should endeavour to enable some grass (this coming spring). We assume what will be good for the breeders of Guernseys will also be good for the breeders of other cattle as well. Why not try out a bit of this kind of silage this year and see for ourselves just what it will do. We know it will tend to lengthen out the period over which one can get the hay crop off — so.

The year 1951 is Census Year for Canada and during the month of June, an army of enumerators will be travelling around the concessions and sidebars gathering a wide range of information which when put together is of immense value to the agricultural industry. A rather comprehensive schedule has been made up and present plans call for an advance distribution of this form throughout the rural areas. In addition, copies will be available through rural post offices. It is hoped that a large number of farmers will thus have an opportunity of studying this schedule and probably completing at least some of the inquiries. This will not only save the time of the farmer during a very busy time of year in June, but will also save the time of the enumerator.
