Fifty-two years ago the Hon. William Fielding, then Minister of Finance for Canada, asked the public for \$37,857,779 in the way of taxes. By the time we were half way through the last war, we were spending \$15,000,000 per day, so that Fielding's Budget of 1897, would have been as through only sixty hours of war. 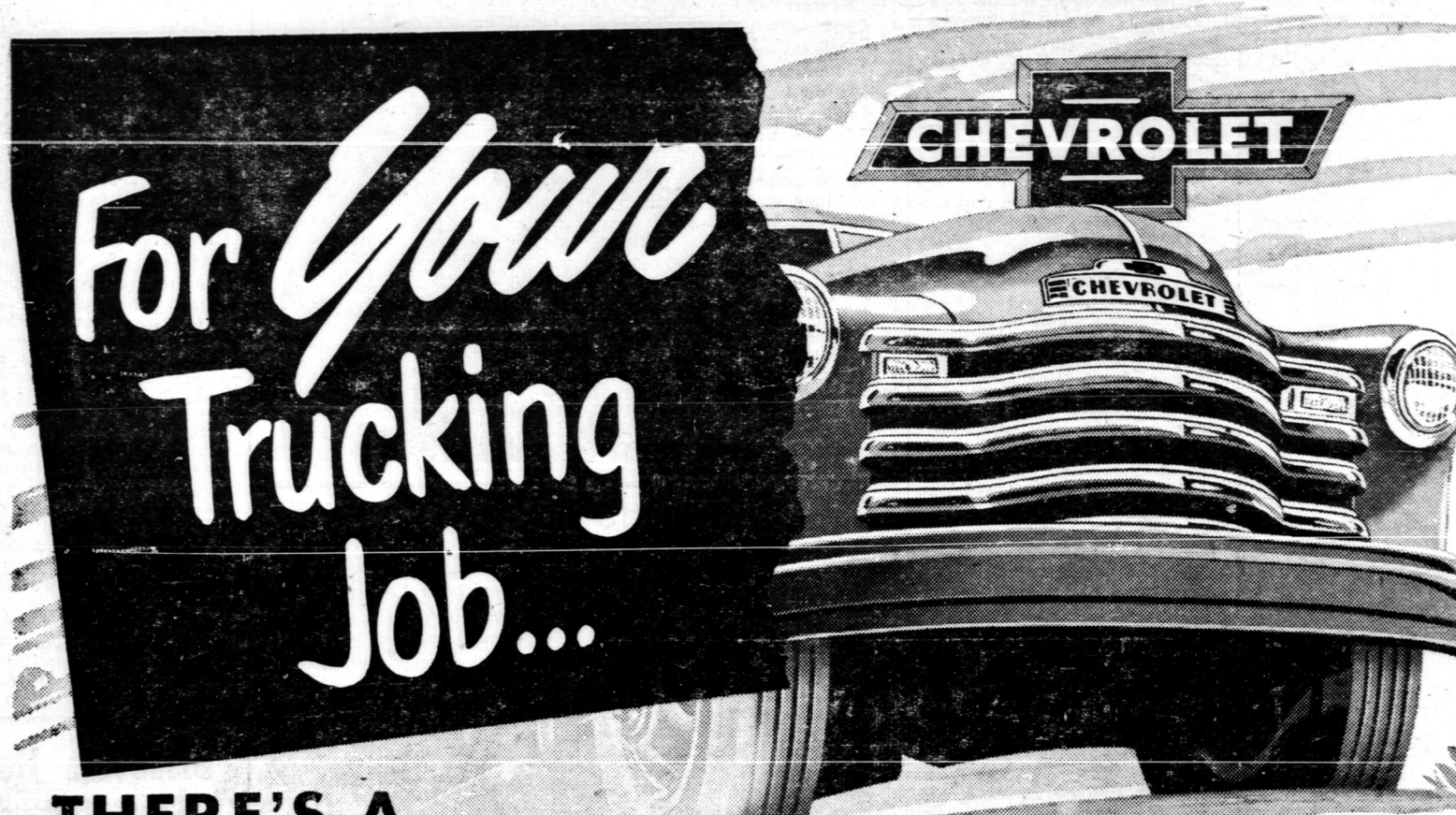
