This is interesting. Of the 110 television stations in operation around the globe, 104 are in the United States, 2 in Britain, 2 in Russia, 1 in France and 1 in Italy. These figures suggest the overwhelming prosperity of the United States as compared with these other countries.

Working forty minutes extra each day, says Mr. Abbott, will result in ten percent increase in production and prevent the grave danger of runaway inflation.
