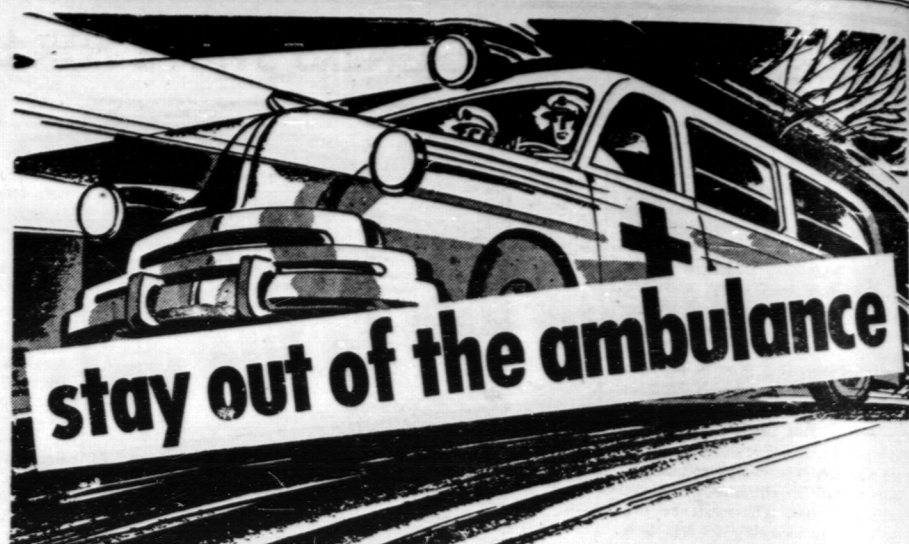
Pen, Scissors and Pastepot

Maybe we just don't understand human nature. Maybe we don't realize the kind of money people carry around in their wallets these days.

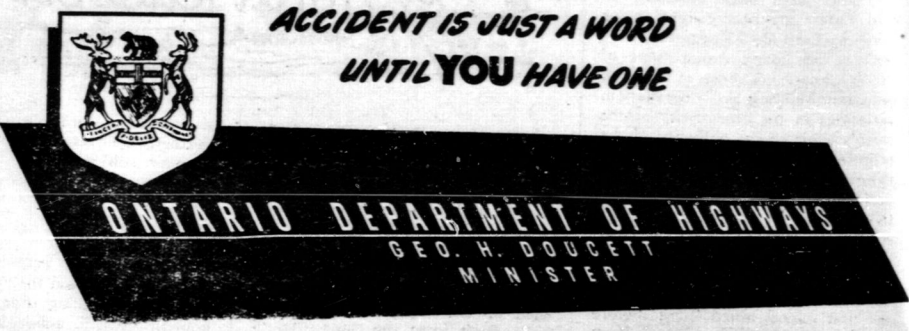

Carroll E. Lindsay MUNICIPAL TAXATION ASSISTANCE WITH THE C.C.F.

In 1952, a C.C.F. Government will pass a special emergency subsidy to all municipalities. This would amount to 10 per cent of all 1951 municipal taxes and would come from present surpluses.

By this action a C.C.F. Government would protect the home-owner against another big jump in taxes on real estate. Last year the average increase in taxes on homes was 10 per cent and municipal taxes were almost 75 per cent higher than in 1945.

It is absolutely necessary that the present crisis in municipal financing should be met, boldly and honestly, by an emergency grant out of the huge surpluses, swollen by inflation, which the Conservative Government of Ontario is accumulating every month.

Promises Or Houses? The housing policy of the provincial and federal government is that of "letting someone else do it". In 1943 Conservative promised the people of Ontario thousands of houses in eight years. THEY HAVE NOT BUILT A SINGLE HOUSE.

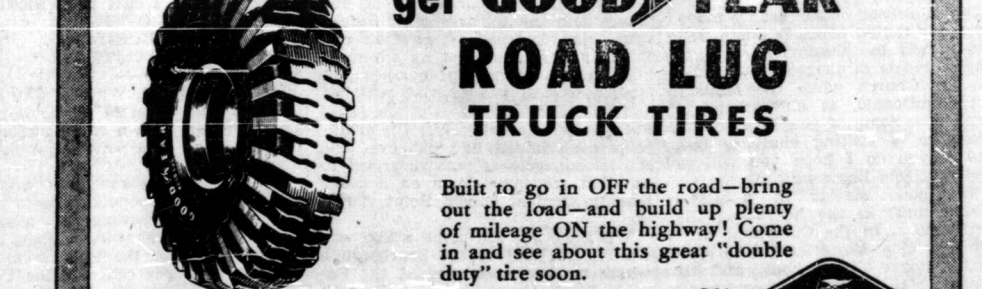
