PETER NEWBERRY WRITES TO JARVIS CHURCH

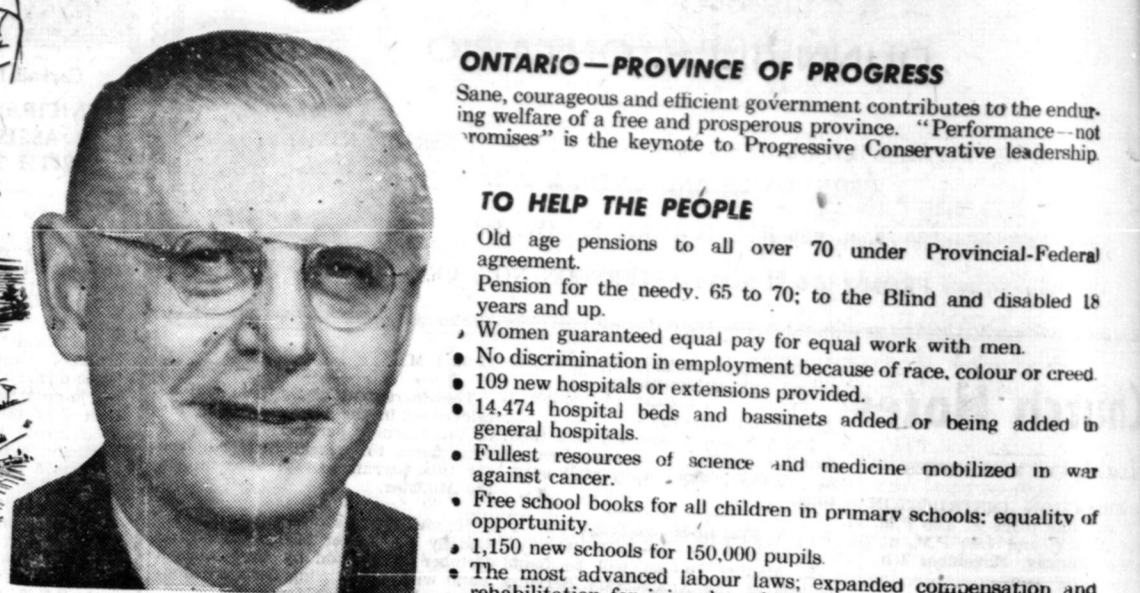
The following letter was received by Raymond Robinson, of Jarvis this week from Peter Newberry:
