Do you know that flies alone can reduce the milk flow as much as 15 per cent and when they are present in large numbers the loss may be much higher? Putting up with them in the farm yard is therefore not only unsanitary but it is unnecessary and in addition very expensive. Spraying with one of the reconstruction of
