**DOMINION ACQUIRES LARGE INCREASED NATURAL GAS SUPPLY**

A new, substantial, long term supply of natural gas for its customers was announced today by the Dominion Natural Gas Company, Limited.

President John R. Reaney stated that "the Dominion Company and the United Natural Gas Company of Canada, Ltd. have recently executed a contract for the sale of natural gas by Union to Dominion".

The contract is for a term of approximately seventeen years, and provides for the minimum sale to the Dominion Company of eight hundred million cubic feet annually, and a maximum of two billion cu. ft. annually.

The new supply of natural gas forms the Dominion Company will originate from several sources, including recent large volume discoveries by Imperial Oil in the Mackenzie region of northern Alberta, also from imports that the Union Company makes from United States.

The Dominion Company is a large producer of natural gas in Ontario, owning some 1500 gas wells. It continually carries on a substantial drilling and exploration program. For the past several years, an average of more than one hundred new wells have been drilled each year.

The Dominion Company is also a purchaser from a great many independent natural gas producers in Ontario. The number of gas wells owned by these producers exceeds seven hundred.

It is expected, said Mr. Reaney, that the present gas supplies supplemented by gas available under the new Union contract, will be sufficient to meet all the requirements of the Dominion customers for many years to come."
