### SOIL SENSE

The Soil Committee for Halton County has always been interested in the younger people, the future farmers of the County.

Last fall projects were started in the four county High Schools and with the Halton Junior Farmers.

The school project was partly a soil survey and partly an essay contest. The Soil Committee outlined the project to the students of each school.

Over 200 soil samples were taken and sent to the Ontario Agricultural College for testing.

The project for the Junior Farmers is in the form of a lecture series followed by an essay contest.

The Soil Committee has selected an essay on the importance of soil testing in the farm and owner, have been given to the boys.

Four evening lectures were arranged with speakers from Guelph and Toronto to speak to the boys on Soil Crops, Livestock and Machinery.

From the information obtained at the lectures the description of the farm and their own experience, the Junior Farmers are asked to draw up a 5-year program for the farm.

The Halton Junior Farmers Association has donated \$50.00 for the three best plans submitted. At this writing three of the lectures have been given.

The fourth and last lecture is on January 14th. After the judging of farm plans the location of the farm will be disclosed. The Committee hopes to arrange a field trip to the farm later this year.

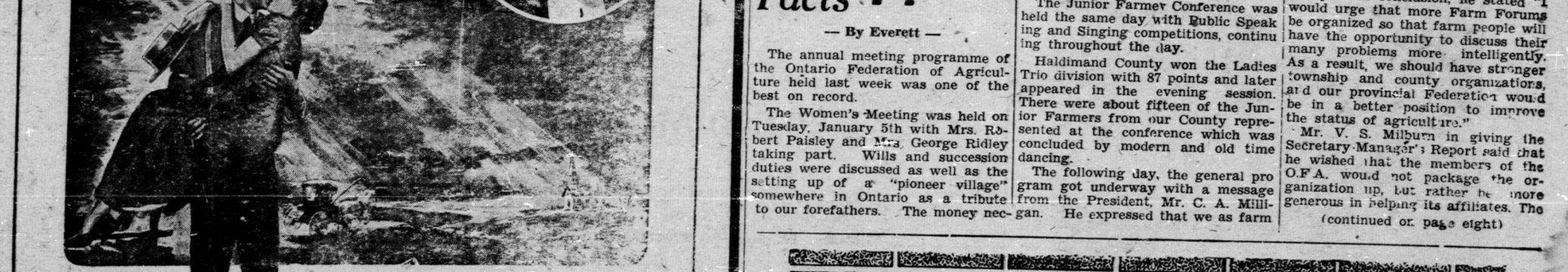

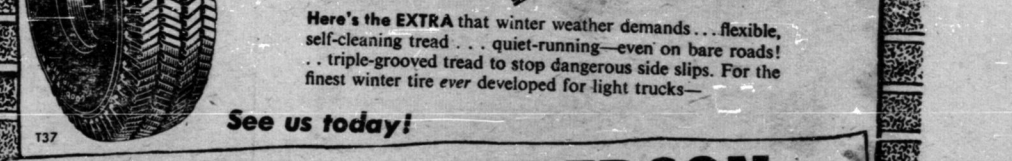
