

BRIEF NOTES FOR THE BUSY FARMER

There is still time to put some oats in the ground. It is suggested that the farmer be sure to consider the latest of the fields over to corn or soybeans or one of the other "catch" crops because of the late planting season. Most farmers want to grow some spring grain for that reason. Corn will be one of the better crops to grow from the standpoint of feed for live stock. Soybeans will be satisfactory on the whole, but the farmer should not fully as a cash crop.

Incidentally there is a revised circular on the growing of soybeans at the end of this issue. It is a good one and if you might get a copy. Ask for Circular Number 173. It is free and it gives all the latest and most important information regarding the growing of soybeans.

Another new circular now available has to do with "Wheels and Tires in Tractor Operation" and that is the care of rubber tires and wheels is always an important factor in obtaining the greatest tractor performance from the farm. This circular describes in some detail the various items that should be considered in the care and maintenance of these parts of the tractor. This circular, No. 194, is a part of a series devoted to the important aspects of tractor operation and may be obtained now at the office of your Agricultural Representative.

Your attention is directed to the fact that the month of May is the best time to plant corn. This is because the soil is warm and the corn will grow rapidly during the past few weeks. Fortunately the weather is susceptible to 24-D at rates of 8 to 10 oz. of seed per acre. It is a very helpful aid in the control of weeds. It is a very helpful aid in the control of weeds. It is a very helpful aid in the control of weeds.

During the month of April Haldimand hog producers marketed a total of 1712 hogs or almost 600 less than during the same month of 1953. Of this number 400 or 23.4 per cent were in the top or "A" grade. This does not compare very favourably with April of 1952 when 55.26 per cent of the hogs were in the same grade. Likewise there has been a drop of a fraction of one per cent from last month. In spite of the fact that there were 600 fewer hogs marketed this past month, there were actually more "C" grade hogs sold than a year ago. It should be kept in mind that under the new regulations "C" grade hogs suffer a reduction of \$3.00 per cwt. and that means quite a loss for the producer.

It took 177 bushels of corn to make 100 lbs. of live hog in value in Chicago last month. This is the highest corn-hog ratio for April in history. A year ago it was 14.2 and two years ago it stood at 9.3. It is easy to guess what the results of this will be and producers should be on their guard in case there will be a serious break in the market.
