

Though the Community, the Government, and the Church are interested in the education of our children, yet the parents are held responsible by God for the training of their children and to Him parents must give account. is for that Scriptural reason that our Christian Schools are parent-controlled schools. The child belongs first of all not to the State, nor to the Community, nor to the Church, but to the parents. That fact was also understood in the U.S.A. by the Oregon Supreme Court which in 1924 upheld the "liberty of parents and guardians to direct the up-bringing of children under their control." That same fact is undoubtedly recognized also in this fine country

which also officially desires to be Christian. Now something about the set-up in our parent-con-trolled Christian Schools. Frank E. Gaebelein in his book "Christian Education in a Democracy" (1951) writes on that as follows: "A group of like-minded parents band together in a Christian School Society. They may not be of the same denomination, but they are convinced that their children must have God-centered and Christ-honoring education. Thus linked in a common purpose, they establish a school. Teachers are secured. Suitable classroom space, sometimes in a hospitable Church, sometimes in a separate building, is obtained. Tuition is fixed at a minimum. The curriculum is planned to accord with State requirements as well as with Christian principles, and the school is launched. Out of simple beginnings such as these, Christian day schools have arisen all over the country.........Standards are generally high......There are also strong Christian high schools, offering accredited

work." (page 107).
