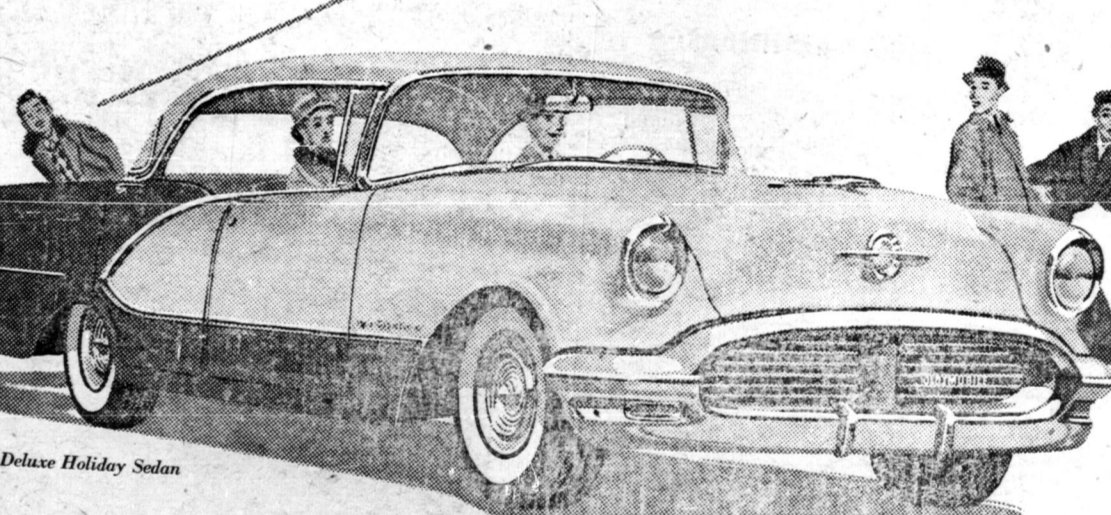


WITH THE CUBS AND SCOUTS

Mr. A. Gordon Skinner brought greetings from the Department of Agriculture, and thanked the W.I. branches for their interest and assistance in his department.

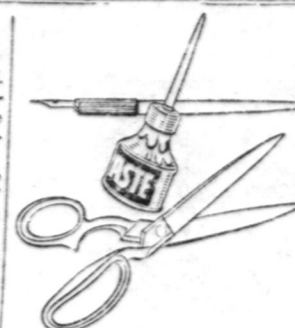
The boys decided to have their first Scout Dance in their new hall on Friday, April 12th.

Most farm employment agencies report little or no activity in this field so far this year.
