As the fall and winter feeding sea son approaches, would it not be good idea to start some kind of system to record the production each cow in the herd? There really no way of knowing what are many ways of doing this. If the cattle are pure bred they can be entered under R.O.P. and very accurate records can be obtained. There is also another scheem that has re ved the approval of the Department of Agriculture whereby the milk

This one day-a-month system ilso used in the D.H.I.A. work and hether or not the herd is unde R.O.P. or D.H.I.A. fairly accurate infore recommended that more dairy herds in Haldimand be put under some organized and regular method of determining the production per cow. More complete information can be had on application to the local offic of the Department of Agriculture.

Records such as these will be in valuable in pointing out the low pro-ducers in the herd—cows that should be eliminated. There is really no use in getting this information if it also help the owner or dairyman feed according to what he finds the pail. Some cows are overfed for the simple reason that they do ot produce in proportion to the feed they receive. On the other hand others er cows may be able to produce mor er cows may be able to produce more if they are fed properly. There is still another advantage to be gained from these records and that is they will point out the better cows from which replacements for the herd can

Are you interested in growing a few strawberries for family use or for the market?
