U.F.O. Officially Ends

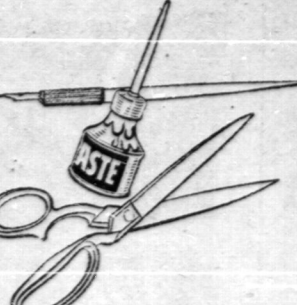
The United Farmers of Ontario which in 1919 became the only party ever to break the Liberal-Conservative rule in Ontario when it was elected despite a lack of funds, organization or experienced political leaders, officially ended its existence last week, when its charter was surrendered to the provincial secretary's office.

The party was never a political threat after its one victory, and it has been dormant for the last 39 years. But it leaves behind some of the province's most colorful political memories as well as some pioneering legislation.

It almost stumbled into active politics in 1918, four years after it was formed, to protest the federal government's refusal to accede to farmers' objections to their sons' loss of their draft-exemption. The next year it found itself in power under E. C. Drury of Grills, now 79 and Sheriff of Simcoe County.

Disagreement on a platform within the party led its downfall in the 1922 election, when the Conservatives won. Two members of the present legislature, Liberal Harry Nixon and Liberal leader Farquhar Oliver, were first elected as U.F.O. supporters.
