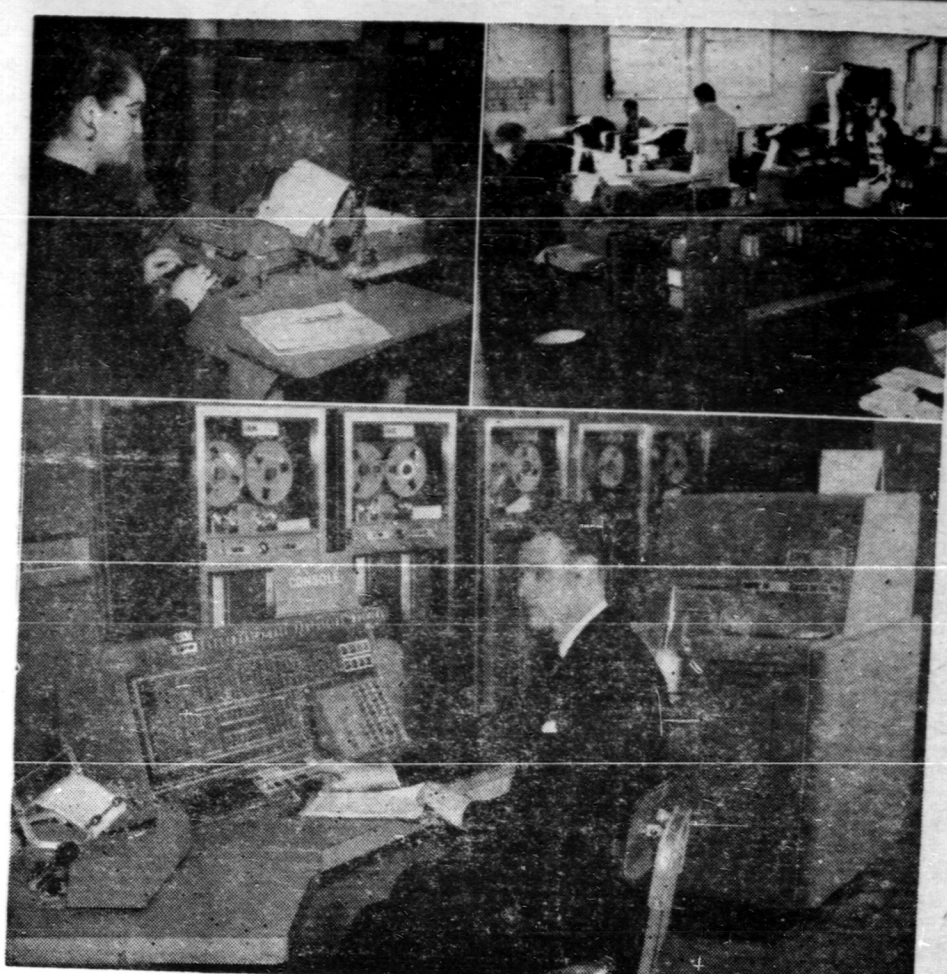
On the other hand, Jarvis deserved to lose. The boys just didn't play good ball and the disease seems to be affecting nearly every player on the team.

Natural Gas From Alberta to California

Plans for a 1,200-mile natural gas pipeline from Alberta to California were announced at Toronto yesterday by B. M. Fair, President of Canadian Bechtel Limited.

The Alberta companies are Canadian Western Natural Gas Company, Calgary and Northwestern Utilities Limited, Edmonton.

The pipeline will have an initial capacity of 400 million cubic feet of gas per day. Originating in the Alberta foothills, the line will follow the Rockies and will enter the Pass. From there it will cross the United States in Idaho and will traverse the Rocky Mountains and terminate in the San Francisco Bay area.
