Haldimand County Children's Aid Society

What groups could be contacted in the summer months by the Children's Aid Society for help in finding a home for three or four children, was one of the questions posed to the Board meeting, in Cayuga on Tuesday evening. These three, one, one and one, are in desperate need of secure homes immediately. Mr. J. McCree, social worker, told the group, "They are not, of course, on the street, but they are in a state of limbo, waiting for a home. In answer to a question, it was stated that a suitable home is not necessarily one with modern conveniences. Loving care is far more important than running water and gas. Children who have been battered so early in life.

Mr. T. D. Jackson in his monthly report remarked that "more teen age boys are being taken into care than ever before. However, he continued, adoption is up over comparable periods in other years and this is the most satisfying experience for a worker for Children's Aid. The fast-track permanent home can be obtained for a child the better future citizen."

Protection cases (preventive work) are up 50 per cent over last year as well as a decided upswing in special short term services. Both of these are areas of work financed by the annual campaign. CAMPAIGN AGAINST SPEEDERS

Canada is in its first month of a three-month vacation time campaign against the "ina-hurry" motorists. It is too early to judge the trend of the drive or to estimate its effect, but evidence has reached its sponsor, the Canadian Highway Safety Council, that agencies all across the nation are taking up the cudgels in rain, fog, heavy traffic, road construction and other hazards, ignoring speed restrictions in built-up sections. "It's the impact on the highway, but he neglects what he knows," says the Conference.

This campaign has the support of Canada's Governor General and the Prime Minister, the Provincial Premiers as well as the President of the United States and State Governors. Transport and transit groups are working at it and the public has been urged to participate as strongly as they can.

Police, magistrates and judges, provincial and community safety organizations, provincial government departments and officials, industry and various associations and societies are being urged to participate as strongly as they can.
