WHOOPIING CRANES FLYING

The near-extinct whooping crane has begun their fall migration from the North-western Territories to Texas, and federal wildlife officials at Ottawa issued their semi-annual plea to sportsmen and others along the route to spare the big birds.

Only 12 whoopers are known to exist in the world, and few of them are in captivity. The others winter in Texas migrating to and from the north where they latch their young.

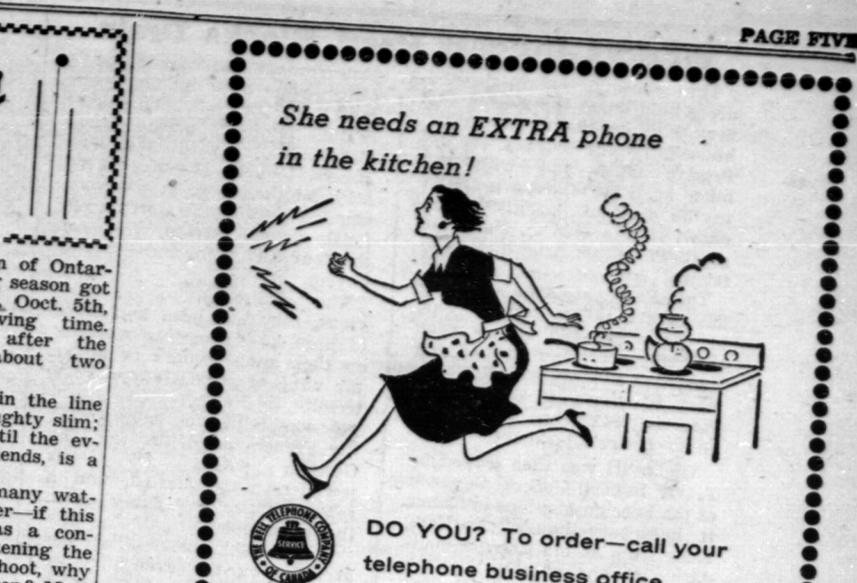

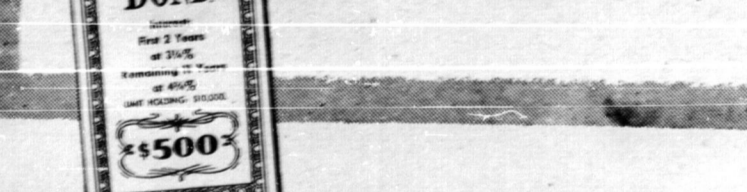
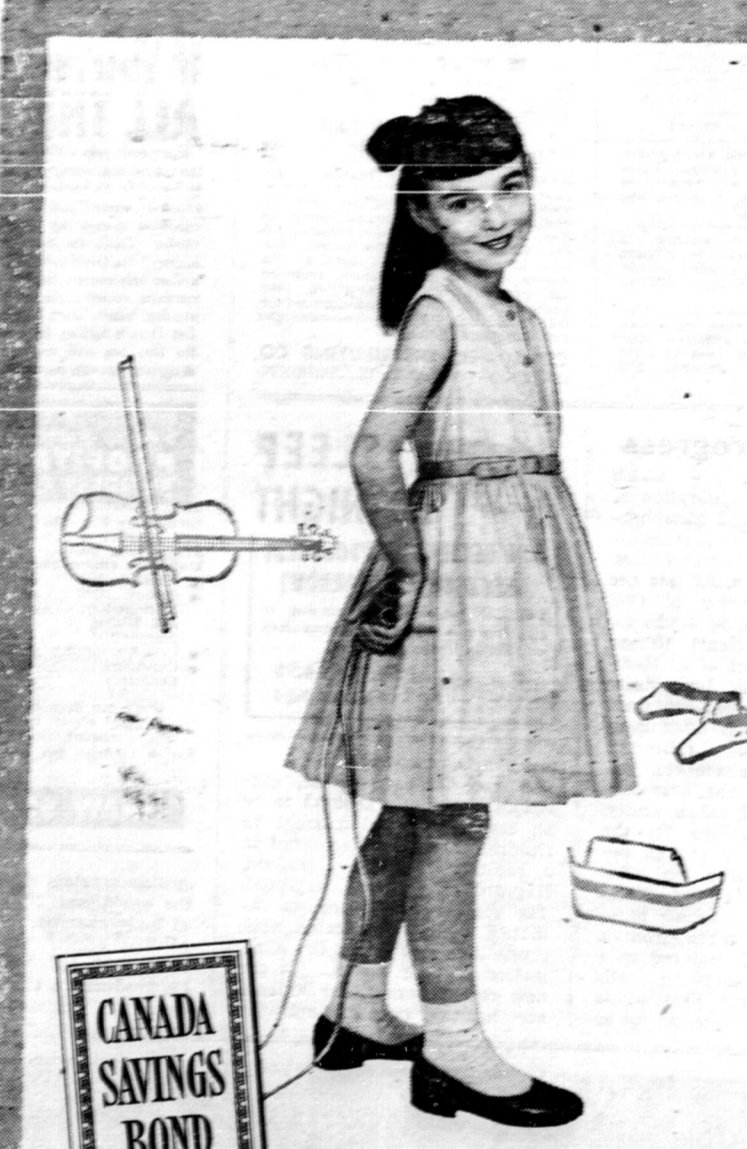
