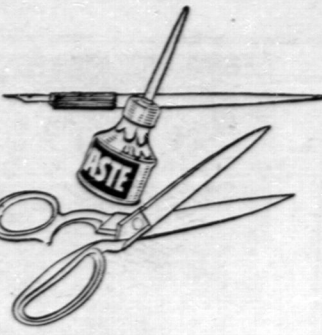

WELLAND CANAL

Canada's Seaway Is Trump Card - Marvin J. Barlow, Professor of Economics of Western Reserve University in Cleveland, and a consultant to industry and the U.S. Government on transportation matters, in an article in Harper's Magazine, entitled "The Coming Battle of the St. Lawrence Seaway" says that the bottleneck at the Welland Canal, which carries more than 50,000,000 tons of cargo annually and the U.S. will demand just over 25,000,000 tons last year. "The Canadians are counting heavily on the seaway as an outlet for land Canada on Canadian soil with Canadian money. Why should American traffic block Canadian shipments out of Canadian waters?" Mr. Barlow then posed this question: "If the Welland Canal is to be enlarged, who will pay for it?" "Spokenmen for the eastern railroads and the Atlantic and Gulf ports will rise with indignation against the massive indignation against hard-earned Canadian taxpayer with the improvement of an all-Canadian facility.

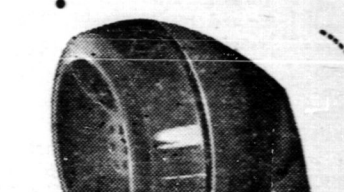
