The single mine employees live in relatively small, semiprivate rooms in company bunkhouses. The boarding house meals, served by caterers selected by Sherritt Gordon, are substantial and carefully planned to give the men variety. Steward Chief Cal Graham pointed out that in addition to the regular meals, the men received a 14-oz. T-bone steak on Saturday night and turkey or chicken for Sunday dinner. A typical week-day menu, and one which I personally enjoyed, was a choice of grilled pork chops, pork hocks, beef tenderloin, cold cut plate, grilled halibut, with soup for a starter and butterscotch pie, jello or fresh fruit salad with chocolate cake for dessert and, of course, tea, coffee or milk. The meals are served cafeteria style and the men may return for follow-up portions. The livingon-camp men pay \$2.25 a day
