Hog Vote Coming Up Soon

With 18 different farm commodities under some degree of supervision by duly accredited marketing boards in Ontario, this province is, these days, getting an intensive schooling in the marketing of its products.

Not long ago peach growers finally finished a vote after a lot of legal pyrotechnics and now a much larger group, the hog producers of Ontario are preparing to go to the polls. A plebiscite on a hog marketing plan is being held on July 26th in 42 counties of old Ontario, south of and not including Muskoka and Haliburton.

Until the voters' list is prepared the exact number of persons eligible to vote can only be estimated. There are about 40,000 commercial hog producers in Old Ontario; there may be some other farmers who raise a few hogs and these will also appear on the voters' list. It is likely that 70,000 would vote this total.

Each of the 42 townships in the counties concerned is considered a voting sub-division, and the township clerk will be the deputy returning officer, with the assessor acting as poll clerk, and they will prepare the list of voters for the poll.

The poll will be held on July 26th at that time and hear applications for revisions of the list. Following the revision of the list a final appeal may be made to the Farm Products Marketing Board at Queen's Park, Toronto, July 14 to 16. After this date no name may be added to the list.

Where farms are situated in a town or village the owner's name should appear on the list and he must vote in the township in which he resides. Polls will be open from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. on voting day, and there will be only one poll per township which will usually be in the township hall. Poll officers will be paid by the Ontario Department of Agriculture, and scrutineers may be appointed by the township clerk.

Any person who produces hogs on his farm is entitled to vote and to be on the list. The owner of the land in the case of a tenant, he and the owner will have the right to vote if the business is conducted in his name. In the case of partnerships or corporations only one vote will be allowed per farm or corporation. There are no age or citizenship requirements for voting.

PREPARATIONS WELL UNDER WAY FOR INTER. FLOWING MATCH

While summer has just begun, all ready to see are whippers of fall in the air with preparations going on for the holding of the International Flowing Match in October.

P. A. Lashley, Secretary-Manager of the Ontario Flowing Match Association, reported recently that applications for space are reaching his office daily and that there is every indication that this year's match at Crayser, Ontario, will see an exceptionally heavy number of exhibitors of machinery and equipment.
