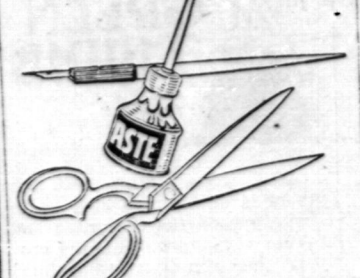

The finance committee of the Halton County Council has decided they will require an increase of 10 per cent to meet the general obligations of the County for the current year. This increase amounts to a little over \$40,000.00. For the year 1957 approximately, to be raised by the local council. The 10 per cent increase will be required to remit an additional \$6,000.00. Grants account, additional costs in the operation of the County Home is the big bite, while it is deemed that the grant because of the carry over of the 1957 costs by as much as \$10,000.00. The finance committee report sets out the budget in detail and it is well presented.

There is one item among the numerous recommended grants which is the most interesting. It is the \$1,000.00 for the Hagersville Arena. We wouldn't want to go to the arena, but we are wondering what the money required to build an arena are not finding it easy to raise. We have not been able to discover what the precedent allowed the finance committee to inject this item in the 1958 budget in view of the already heavy increase in the tax rate. We wouldn't wonder about it except we have been able to discover any evidence of similar generosity on the part of the finance committee when part of the finance committee Hall was built. It is nice to know, however, that the committee views favourably community projects in the category of ice arenas and we must keep this in mind when we proceed with a similar project here.

In 1956-57 by the conservation officers in the Lake Erie District of Southern Ontario, it is estimated that the deer in the County of Halton stood at 6,184, or 11.3 deer per square mile. The population in nine Lake Erie counties was 22,176. The population in this county was almost double the next highest. The Halton County Game and Forests to give consideration to a deer study in order to reduce the number of deer. The desirability of reducing the number of deer in the county can hardly be questioned. However, an open season could be fraught with danger to the populace. Our experiences in the sparsely settled northland during the hunting season forced us to conclude that it is a dangerous pastime. If an open season is granted deer hunters in Halton would want to go north until it is over.
