He wants to compete in the economic and industrial world markets. He wants to extend Russian trade with the United States and other Free World countries solely for the purpose of competing in these markets with the products of Soviet slave labor industries.

To put it picturesquely, Mr. Khrushchev chews a nuclear rocket in one hand, and a dove in the other, and he is offering us the choice of being peacefully absorbed into a World Soviet Socialist Republic, or being blown to pieces.
