We have been editing the Record for the past twenty five years and are happy to state we have several hundred subscribers who have been taking the paper since that date.

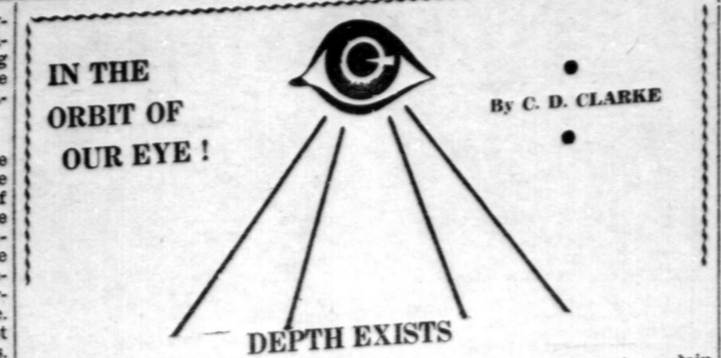
