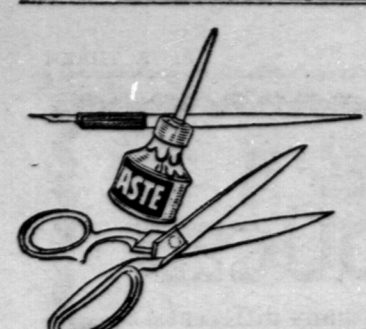


LETTERS TO THE EDITOR
