The new telephones will be required when the Jarvis exchange is converted to dial operation. Until that time, telephone users wishing to place calls will simply remove the receiver and the operator will answer. The dial will not be used.

D. A. McArthur, Bell Telephone manager for this area, said the new telephones are being installed well ahead of time so that all will be ready when the change-over is made.

eady when the change-over is made.
Mr. McArthur said that Jarvis would be the first community in this part of Canada to use "All Number Calling," (A.N.C.) the telephone Calling," (A.N.C.) the telephone numbering system which, it was recently announced, will gradually be introduced throughout Canada and the United States.

With this type of numbering each with this type of numbering each telephone number consists of seven figures. All Jarvis telephone numbers will begin with a three-figure exchange code, 587, and this will be followed by four other figures. A typical Jarvis telephone number might be 587-1234.

Mr. McArthur said that this type of numbering plan had been adopted

Mr. McArtnur said that this type of numbering plan had been adopted after close study of many possible numbering systems and had been found most suitable for use under found most suitable for use under modern telephone calling conditions. The studies indicated that the A.N.C. numbers are as easy to remember as those in other numbering systems that might have been adopted. Furthermore, they offer the greatest scope for use in local and long distance calling.

A.N.C. numbers are considered ideal for use with "Direct Distance Dialing," the service which enables telephone users to dial their own long distance calls, and which will be introduced in Javis in the future.




