FOR THOSE OF YOU who are interested | tached to each bird, begin diving and ducking master must operate the strings, keep the birds from becoming entangled and watch for birds who have fish in their throats. The bird when gorged will swim in a helpless way, with its head and swollen neck erect. It is lifted by the master into the boat where the fish is squeezed out of the bird's mouth. In the meantime the other eleven birds remain in the water and dexter-

ously the other bird is again placed in the water. The trained bird captures from two to four good-sized ayu each time it is placed in the water, and averages forty or fifty fish a night under ideal conditions. They are fed and cared for very well and only after they have done their

As a tourist seeing cormorant fishing there are many things which add to the delight of the fishing itself. We were in one of the many boats in the flotilla and while we awaited the sight of the fishing we were entertained by fireworks, music, girls doing Japanese dances on another boat, refreshments and dishes of Ayu trout served on a low table on the floor of the pleasure craft Everyone was singing and laughing. It was a beautiful sight to see all the paper lanterns and fireworks from boats sitting in the darkness along the river's edge. I would surely recommend this treat to any who travel to Japan.
