However, He immediately rushed them off to the Alps, in Switzerland, where they were part of a five man climbing party trying to scale a sheer wall of ice, near the summit, when last bottom man lost his footing pulling the three before him out into space, held only by the rope tied on our leader. He likened the rope to our faith in the "Top Man", Jesus Christ, who can save us from a plunge to sure death and trust in Him. Council Ring ended as silently as it had begun and even after the closing benediction, several lingered momentarily, seriously pondering the thought of a life in the shadow of the cross.
