Now's the time of year to give your laying flock extra light; about 14 to 15 hours is best. Use 1/4 watt per square foot, or a uniform light intensity of 1 foot-candle, suggests John Walker, Ontario Agricultural College poultry management specialist. Use 60 to 100-watt bulbs placed 10 to 12 feet apart on a 6 to 8 foot ceiling. Place the outside rows of lights half this distance (3 to 6 feet) from the wall. This should provide enough light without reflectors.

Federation

Facts

The Ontario Federation of Agriculture presented its brief to the Prime Minister and the members of the Ontario Cabinet on Monday, December 11th. Included in this brief were requests for Ontario participation in the proposed federal programme of rural development (ARDA), continuation by the Ontario Department of Agriculture of the search for export markets for Ontario farm products begun last year; research into the socio-economic impact of large-scale, vertically integrated, corporate farms; assistance of the research facilities of the Ontario Government in ascertaining the economic feasibility of national marketing boards; research into the feasibility of marketing control as a function of marketing boards; informational programme to acquaint farmers with the merits of selling cattle through the Ontario Stock Yards; provision of arrangements for the greater security of livestock to community livestock sales; reduced licence fees for farm trucks; Separate Workman's Compensation Act designed to meet the needs of farmers and farm workers.
