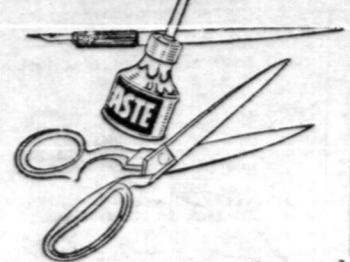

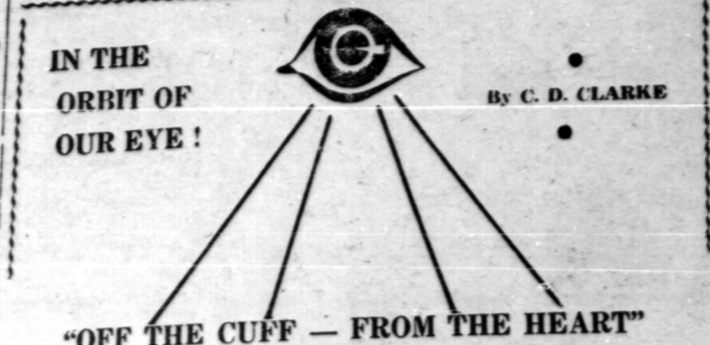
Ontario's Fair Accommodation Practices Act will be amended to prohibit discrimination in the renting of apartments in buildings that contain more than six units.

Premier Frost introduced the amendment Tuesday in the Legislature. It reads: "No person, directly or indirectly, alone or with another, by himself or by the interposition of another, shall deny to any person of a class of persons occupancy of any dwelling unit in any building that contains more than six self-contained dwelling units because of the race, color, creed, nationality, ancestry or class of persons."

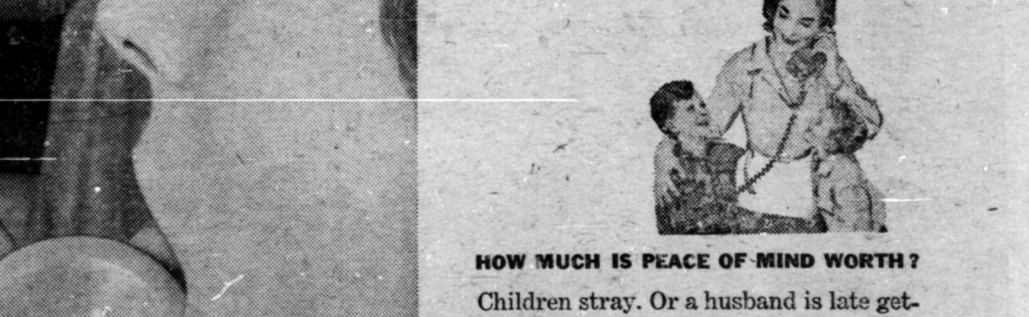
