PARK TO EXPAND

A \$5,000 grant for an "approved park" in Haldimand, has been announced by Provincial Treasurer Allan, MIAA for Norfolk Haldimand. Haldimand County proposed to convert an 80-acre public park into an "approved park."

An additional 10 acres will be added to the south end of the existing park. The property is on the north shore of Lake Eric at Peacock Point and is owned by the county.

The park will have 1,065 feet of shoreline. It has a picnic area, bathing conveniences and toilet facilities.
