NEW TELEPHONE BOOKS ISSUED
 (intended for a previous issue)
 The panorama of Jarvis which in recent years has spread to many areas of the telephone industry, has been expanded to include the new phone directories, D. A. McArthur, Bell Telephone manager for this district, said this week.
 "The familiar blue shade of directory covers is gone," Mr. McArthur said, "and the 1961 edition of the telephone book for Jarvis has turquoise-colored covers. In addition, the book cover carries many of our colored sets as well as the newest member of the telephone family - 'The Family' - which was recently introduced throughout Ontario."
 A feature of the front cover is a sketch of the Alexander Graham Bell Memorial in Brantford. This illustration replaces the sketch of the Oxford County Courthouse in Woodstock which appeared on last year's cover.
 "The new directory should be placed in use as soon as it is received," Mr. McArthur said, "with the exception of the Brownsville, Kintore and Embro sections. These places are being converted to dial service January 8th and the numbers listed in this directory for those centres will become effective at that time. Until then, the old directories should be retained for telephone number information concerning Brownsville, Embro and Kintore."
 In addition to the new numbers for these communities, Mr. McArthur pointed out that there are many new and changed listings for the other exchanges served by the book. He suggested that one way to avoid confusion over these changes is for each customer to amend his Blue Book of Telephone Numbers and other personal lists of frequently called numbers, and to consult them before placing calls.
 Extra copies of the Blue Book may be obtained free of charge from any Bell business office.
 Jarvis subscribers received 600 copies of the directory this year, compared with 620 in 1959. Total circulation in the area served by the book will be 93,850, an increase of 638 over last year's distribution figure.
 The directory now being distributed here also serves Woodstock, Brantford, Ingersoll, Paris, Simcoe, Tillsonburg, Cayuga, Delhi, Hagersville, Norwich, Port Dover and Port Rowan.
