If you miss it at the office get one dinary seed treatments and the most ous year. Actually the best method of doing this is to use either registered or certified seed. Even here there is a tolerance which might even be considered excessive in some quar-ters. For instance, registered seed may have as much as 4 per cent infected seeds while certified seed may have double this percentage. This serves to emphasize the difficulty of keeping this disease under control. The tolerance is there only because it is impossible to produce enough seed with less than this amount for com-

mercial purposes.
-oOoIf you are contemplating the purchase of a bull, be sure to keep the Ontario Bull Sale in mind. -oOo Heat lamps are an excellent way of supplying additional heat to young pigs in a farrowing pen, but for the barn's sake, support these lamps with light chain not binder twine. A fire can so easily be started if the string should break and the lamp come in direct contact with the straw or oth-er litter. The red pyrex lamps, while more expensive, are also much safer, since they will not crack if splashed with water. They will last much-longer too. longer too.

The cost of teaching Driver Education in high school is about \$35 per graduate, says the Ontario Safety League. But the (U.S.) National Safety Council calculates that since the course reduces violations and accidents by 50 %. Driver Education SAVES graduates \$72 per year for the first several years of driving. It also saves graduates from some of the possibilities of incurring far greater expense the immeasurable cost of becoming involved in a situation that leads to human tragedy.


