



The members of the Haldimand County Parks Board must have felt some considerable satisfaction on Sunday when the new County Park at Lake Erie was officially opened. The interest of the public in this undertaking was manifest by the large crowd in attendance. The warm rays of the sun and the refreshing breeze from the lake provided the two elements that will find favor with the many people who will visit the park in the years to come. As was pointed out by the Hon. Jas. N. Allan, in his remarks at the official opening, succeeding generations will remember with gratitude the foresight of those who made the facilities possible. In the forefront of those who must be remembered is Ted Montague, Reeve of Walpole Township, who gave the project the needed enthusiasm in the initial stages and who continues as Chairman of the Parks Board.

James E. Coyne no longer is governor of the Bank of Canada. But before he resigned his post, the 51-year-old banker saw to it that for years to come his name would jump to mind whenever that institution is mentioned. He turned into a raging crusader and evoked more controversy and emotion on Parliament Hill than veterans of the political ring had ever seen before.

His pitched battle with the Conservative government lasted exactly 21 days. It started June 13 with Mr. Coyne's disclosure that Finance Minister Fleming had demanded his resignation two weeks earlier. Mr. Coyne said it was his duty to resist the government's will to dismiss him because no issue of policy had arisen between them.

**QUIT VOLUNTARILY**  
The struggle ended July 13 when the governor resigned voluntarily after a rebellious Liberal majority in the Senate killed the government-sponsored bill to force his resignation.

Mr. Coyne, in resigning, declared himself satisfied that his personal honor and the integrity of his office had been upheld. But the action of the Senate's Liberal majority may have been another shot in the battle that could affect the future status of the Senate itself. A day earlier, the upper chamber refused to back down on its amendment to the government's tariff bill, a refusal Prime Minister Diefenbaker had warned could lead "sooner or later" to a general election fought on the issue of Senate reform.

The Senate vote of 33 to 16, on paper, no longer we're afraid we'll have to accept it whether we liked it or not. What special privileges did Mr. Coyne hold? We don't know who is right and fail to see how any layman can stand up and say he does. The government, while his responsibility to the people, say Mr. Coyne was wrong and that is a privilege they have a right to enjoy.

We have to thank the Mayor of all the people of Jarvis for a nice boat ride the other night, and for a mess of fish that kept food on our table for three days.
