Majority of the registered egg producers in Canada are small operators producing less than 4,000 dozen grade A large or extra large eggs each year.

According to figures compiled by the Canada Department of Agriculture, 93 per cent of all egg producers in Canada are covered 100 per cent by the Agricultural Stabilization Board.

Grade A Large eggs are supported by the Agricultural Stabilization Board at 33 cents per dozen.
