- 1 cup mashed ripe bananas (about 3)
- 2 cups flour
- 1 teaspoon soda (scent)
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 5 tablespoons milk
- 1/2 cup nuts, chopped
- Sift flour, baking powder, soda, salt, and sugar together; add nuts. Add ungreased egg-mashed bananas, and shortenening. Mix thoroughly in lightly but quickly. Pour into a greased, 8-inch loaf pan and bake at 325° F. about 50 minutes.

DATE BREAD
1 cup dates, cut up
1 teaspoon soda
1 cup boiling water
1 tablespoon butter, melted
1/2 cup brown sugar
1 egg
1/2 cups flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup nut meats
Combine dates and soda; pour boiling water over them. Cook over low heat until thick (if it becomes too thick, add a little more water). Add butter and let cool. Combine brown sugar and egg and add to date mixture. Sift together the flour and salt and add to first mixture; add nuts. Pour into greased loaf pan and bake at 325° F. for 50 minutes.

CRANBERRY BREAD
1 cup cranberries, chopped
1/2 cup English walnuts, chopped
1 cup sugar
2 cups flour
2 tablespoons shortening
2 cups fruit
Juice of 1 orange plus boiling water to make 1 cup
1 egg, beaten
1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon soda
Sift together the egg, shortening, orange juice and rind; add cranberries and nuts. Pour into greased loaf pan. Bake at 325° F. for 50 minutes.

LEMON BREAD
6 tablespoons butter
1 cup sugar
2 unbeatened eggs
1/2 cup milk
1 1/2 cups flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
Cream butter and sugar together and add eggs; mix. Add milk. Sift together the flour, salt, and baking powder and add to first mixture; then add grated lemon rind. Pour into greased loaf pan and bake 1 hour at 350° F.

SAUCE
Grated rind of 1/2 lemon
1/4 lb. of cup sugar
Combine these ingredients and pour over loaf after you've taken it out of the oven, but before you've removed it from the pan.

2 eggs

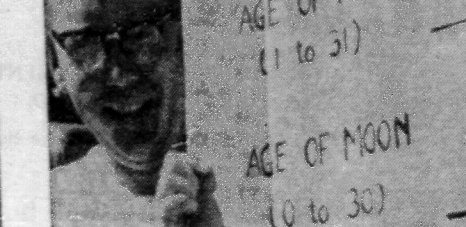
