It was recently reported that 5000 head had been brought into the province during recent months under the Federal-Provincial Sheep Assistance Policy. A few flocks of 300 to 400 head were established but in the majority of cases the buyers settled for 50 to 100 ewes. Just in this connection there seems to be some interest in sheep in Haldimand. A new 4-H Sheep Club has been organized this past month — the first for the County.

Mr. Watson, formerly Live Stock Commissioner for Ontario, has two suggestions to offer to intending purchasers.
